

### Iridium Internet Short Message Service

The Iridium short message service allows for 160 character text to be sent to an Iridium phone or pager via the Iridium website.

With Iridium Internet Short Message Service, you simply:

1. Open a web browser and type: <http://www.iridium.com>.
2. Click on Send a Satellite Message (found in the top right-hand corner).
3. In the To field, type in the entire Iridium phone number.
4. In the Reply email field, type in your email address.
5. In the message, type in a short message. Remember, you only have 160 characters, and spaces, commas and periods count!
6. Click on the Send Message button.
7. A brief window will open to show the progress of your message.
